

Family Learning Event in Skye – July 2010

The Community Learning & Development Review Group for Gaelic (CLAD) is pleased to announce that a Family Learning event for Gaelic-speaking families will be held at Sabhal Mòr Ostaig (SMO) on the Isle of Skye during the week beginning **Monday 5th July 2010**.

This week-long event is open to families with children being educated through the medium of Gaelic and offers the opportunity for parents to attend one of the college's language courses while their children take part in a wide range of sports, arts and other activities through the medium of Gaelic.

This year's event will build on the success of previous years' events and the college will again be dedicated to the event for its duration. Last year 32 families from across the Highlands, Islands and the central belt took advantage of the opportunity to learn and play in a Gaelic-speaking environment at the college in Sleat in the south of Skye and all were enthusiastic about the benefits of the experience.

Further information and application forms will be distributed by local authorities to GME schools in their area during January and these must be returned to the Project Co-ordinator by 12th March at the latest.

Places are limited, so early submission of applications is recommended. Families will be advised in early April whether their applications have been successful.
